#### **Developing Independence**

Part of growing up is a child's rite of passage to develop independence, after all, children will hopefully one day grow into adults. It is very important to allow children the opportunity to succeed and also to fail, as it is through disappointment and adversity that they develop resilience.

The understanding that things don't always go in your favour cannot be understated. As parents and teachers we sometimes need to remind ourselves not to get involved and refrain from 'sorting out' an issue for a child.

Real success comes from allowing children to learn for themselves. If we get too involved we may be inadvertently teaching the child that they are not capable of managing for themselves and we may be developing 'learned helplessness.'

Please continue to provide advice and support for your child and I'm sure there will be occasions when

you need to take charge, but also remember that children need to develop independence and experience both success and failure for themselves.

There is a saying, "Progress only happens out of our comfort zone" – children and indeed all of us benefit from the opportunities that come from being out of our comfort zone.

#### **School Attendance**

One of the fundamental characteristics of a sound education is regular attendance. Sick children should not be at school, however we are very clearly aware that some of our children miss far too many days of school and illness is not always the reason.

Quite simply we cannot teach children who are not at school and missing school has a significant detrimental impact not only on education but also on relationships and the broader notion of commitment.

#### **End of Term Dismissal**

Next Friday, June 23 is the final day of the school term. Children will be dismissed at 1.00pm on the day and will not require a school lunch. Term 3 will commence on Monday July 10.



# Children's continence

Does your child often wet the bed, wet their pants, or experience loose bowels or constipation? Many children go through the same issues, and luckily there is help available.

Our continence nurse advisor can assess your child, help you manage referrals to specialists if necessary.

# You may want to see the continence nurse if your child is:

- Six years and older, and wets the bed
- Four years and older, and wets their pants during the day
- Experiencing constipation, soiling, or loose bowels

## Where can I access this service?

Our children's continence service is available for children aged older than two and younger than 18 years. We deliver this service for Latrobe residents across Latrobe Community Health Service sites Churchill, Moe and Morwell. Some outreach visits in the home or school setting may be available on request.
