Head Lice

Head Lice are common in school-aged children and are the most adaptable of creatures, they have survived living solely on humans for 10,000 years. You may be reassured to know that they are commonly found in places other than Morwell Park Primary School, especially given our school isn't 10,000 years old we can't claim them as our own!!!

Some reasons they have survived for so long are:

- The six legs of a louse end in a claw, allowing them to grip the hair.
- They detect vibration and can hide (conditioner will help this problem).
- Head lice can 'hold' their breath for 20 minutes looking like they are dead.
- The eggs are attached to the hair with a 'glue' like substance. Studies conducted on 45 different products to dissolve the 'glue' showed nothing would dissolve it.

The good news...

We know where they live and we know how to find them. If you follow these steps at least once a week, the control of head lice in your home will be greatly improved.

- Step1 Comb inexpensive hair conditioner on to dry, brushed (detangled) hair, making it difficult for lice to grip the hair or run around;
- Step 2 Wipe the conditioner from the comb onto a paper towel or tissue;
- Step 3 Look on the tissue and on the comb for lice and eggs;
- \cdot Step 4 If lice or eggs are found, the child should be treated. Support is available at school -


